The Class Assembly of X D was held on April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2026 on the topic “**How School Prepares Students to Face Challenges in the Competitive World – 3 Ways**”.

The assembly began with the captivating *Tamil Thai Vazhthu*, followed by the Gayatri Mantra and DAV Gaan, performed by the class choir. The comperes’ energy and eloquence guided the assembly, starting with a warm welcome address delivered by Saadhana and Divya Dharshini. The theme of the assembly was presented by Hariharasudhan and Sai Sahana, whose passionate words and articulation set high standards for the programme ahead.

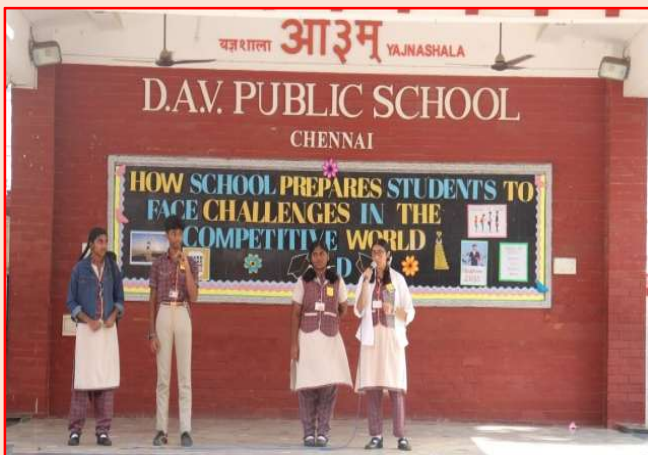

**Evolution of a Student – A Skit**



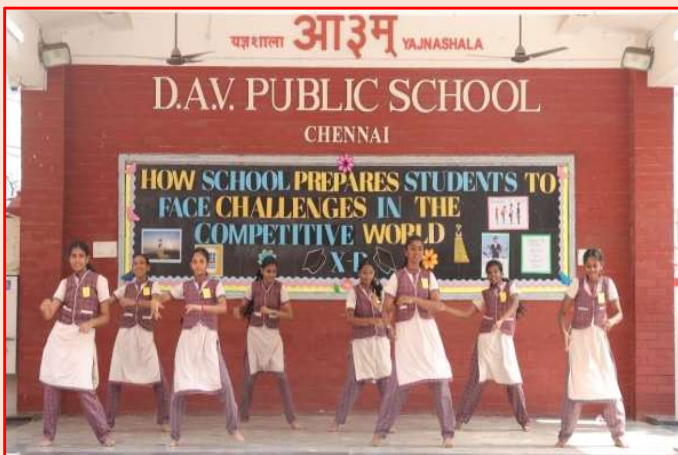

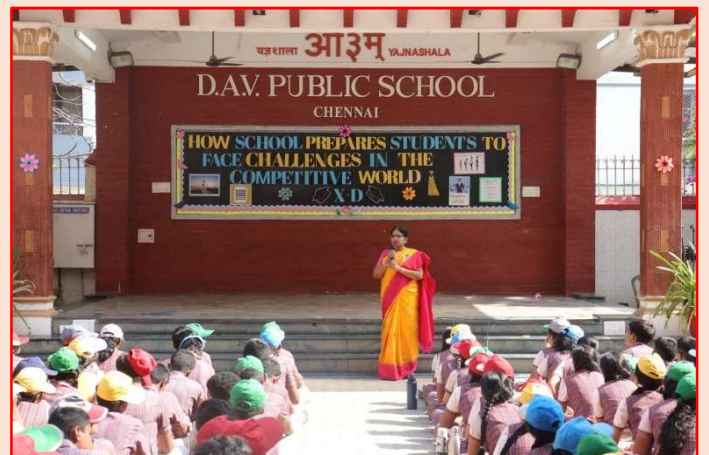
