The Diwali celebration was indeed a blend of devotion, culture, and joy - a perfect reminder that light always triumphs over darkness and togetherness strengthens every bond.



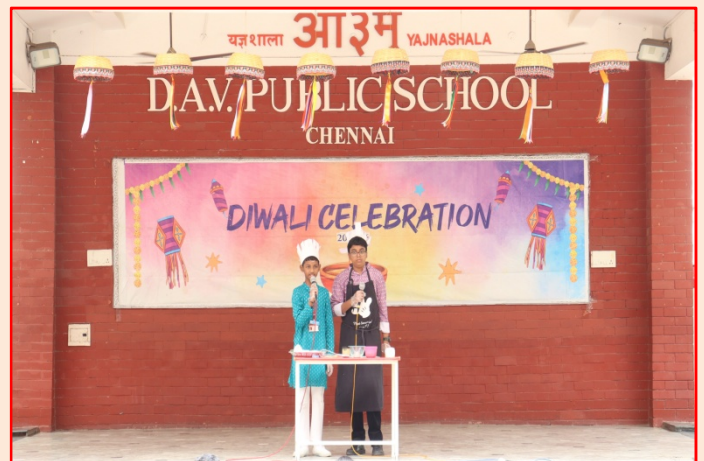

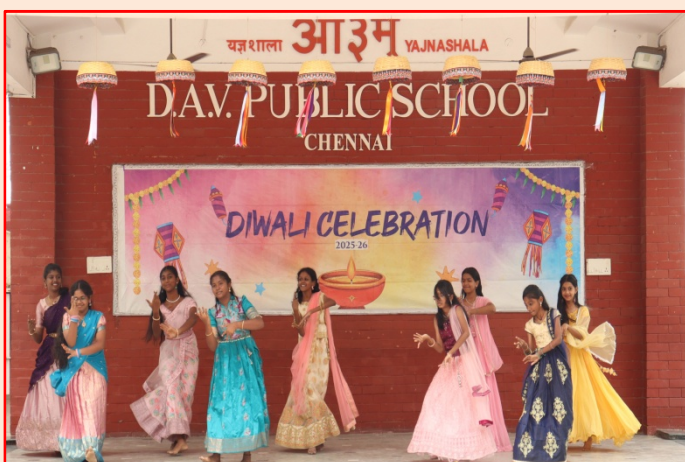
