Through vibrant Pookolam designs, traditional Onam Sadya, captivating dance performances, and


engaging activities, the event brought together students, teachers, and staff in a joyous celebration of

Kerala's harvest festival.


The Celebration not only preserved and promoted Kerala's rich traditions but also fostered a sense of


