Topic: How to Identify Musical Intelligence among Students

The Class Assembly of VI B started with the Gayatri Mantra followed by the DAV Gaan. The Welcome Speech was given by Sai Keshava. He set the tone by highlighting the day's theme - **Musical Intelligence** - and its importance in nurturing creativity and cognitive growth. In his welcome speech he introduced musical intelligence as the ability to perceive, create, and emotionally connect with music and emphasised that every student has the potential to develop this intelligence through participation and practice.

A group of seven students listed the benefits of developing musical intelligence, by highlighting how music enhances memory, emotional expression, and concentration and helps in developing Language skills. Further the speakers reiterated that music promotes teamwork and confidence through choir activities and performances. The Music Choir presented a medley inspired by *The Sound of Music* to show how Music Therapy helps in reducing stress and hospital stays.

Solo Instrumental by Neerav Jithesh was a standout, student-led keyboard performance. It demonstrated melodic interpretation and rhythmic control. Vishuddha and Rakshan spoke about different ways to develop and identify musical intelligence. They include listening to music, joining karaoke events, joining music bands and music clubs.

The students also spoke about the Musical genius - Latha Mangeshkar - her life history and achievements through a “one on one” interview. Surya Dhruti and Sashaanth presented a show “One on One with Latha Mangeshkar”. Reflections on her journey from local performances to becoming a music legend were the highlights of the interview. 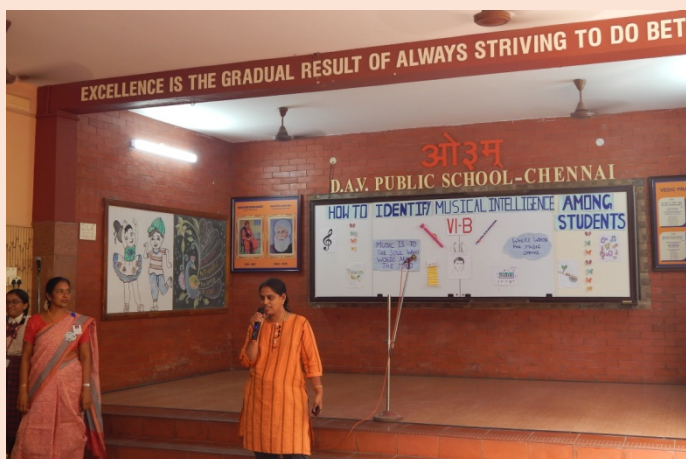
