REPORT ON FIRST EDITION OF DAVPS MODEL UNITED NATIONS 2026

The First Edition of the **DAVPS Model United Nations (DAVPS MUN 2026)** was successfully organised by D.A.V. Public School, Chennai, on 17 and 18 July, 2026, providing an enriching platform for young minds to develop diplomacy, critical thinking, leadership and public speaking skills. The two-day conference brought together 135 delegates from more than 25 schools, making the First Edition a remarkable success.

The conference commenced with an impressive Inaugural Ceremony beginning with Tamizh Thaa Vazhthu, followed by the chanting of the Gayatri Mantra and the ceremonial lighting of the lamp by the Principal, Mrs. Sujatha M, Executive Board Members, Delegates and Teacher Escorts.

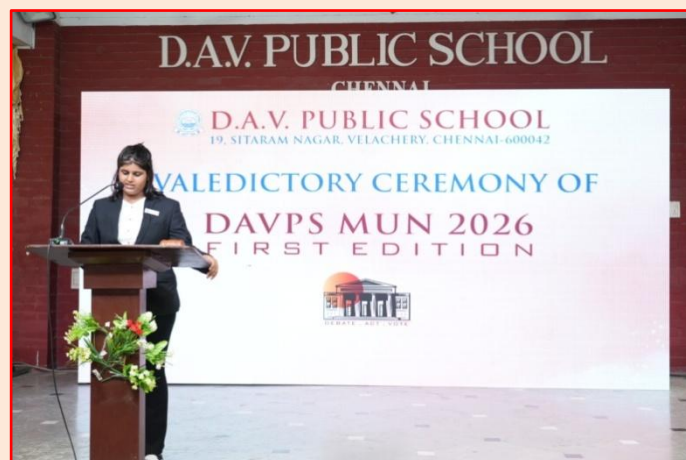
